

1 bowl, 1 spoon, 1 cup

Gather together the items you will need

5. Leave the shapes to dry in a sunny spot.

Now for the fun bit!

Plant your seed bombs by throwing them at bare parts of the garden and wait to see what pops up!

Leave to air dry in the sunshine and sow

Creating your seed bombs in five, very easy steps

Measure the amounts of ingredients into your bowl

2. In a bowl, mix together 1 desert spoon of seeds with 3 dsp of compost and 2 dsp of clay powder

4. Roll the mixture into firm balls, or sausages, your choice.

Mould into your chosen seed bomb shape

Bind together with water

3. Slowly mix in 3 desert spoons of water, stir with your spoon, mix until everything sticks together.

Makes 3 seed bombs

MAKE YOUR OWN PINE CONE BIRD FEEDERS

What you will need:



Open Pine Cones



Peanut Butter



Small Bowl



Popsicle Stick



Bird Seed



Twine or String



Scissors

How to make them:

- Start by attaching your string or twine to the base of the thin end of the pine cone to enable you to hang them up later
- Place some seeds in a small bowl
- Using the popsicle stick, push the birdy peanut butter into the gaps of the pine cone
- Once done, push bird seeds into the butter until your cone is full from top to bottom
- Then for the best bit, hang the feeder in your garden and wait for the birdies to come and eat the seeds
