Construction Update

- 1 Deepcut Bridge Road Environmental Improvement Works: This month we will be removing existing kerbs and infrastructure before diverting utility services (telecoms and power). For the latest updates on progress, please visit our dedicated webpage at mindenhurst.co.uk/news/dbr-works.
- 2 The team has finished clearing the **Formal Park** site and will begin excavation works in October. These excavations will take place below the surface level and are required to form the footpaths that will link Deepcut Bridge Road to Mindenhurst Road.
- 3 New drainage has been installed along **Brunswick Road**. The team will now begin installing utility services, mainly power and telecoms.
- Southern SANG: New paths are being created to link the Central SANG with the Southern SANG, running down to the Frimley Lock cycle route and canal pathways. We will also commence work on new paths between the Cala Homes site (South) and the Frimley Lock cycle path. Works will continue on the southern sustainable urban drainage system where we are creating extra capacity in the drainage network.
- 5 **St Barbara's Church** external refurbishment is largely complete. The final works will be completed this month, including new cladding on the spire.
- **6 DIO Road Improvement Works (South):** We are working southwards along Newfoundland Road towards Bovis Homes' main site entrance. Works have also started on Union Road.
- **7 DIO Road Improvement Works (North):** Works to upgrade the roads to Surrey County Council standards will begin at the end of October 2023. We will carry out phased works along Cyprus Road which require a 10-12 month road closure. More information will be sent to the residents impacted by this activity.



8 We will prepare for the upcoming archaeological investigations by clearing this area and removing trees.

Planning news

Proposals for the Northern Area ANGST, Allotments, DIO Roads North and the Formal Park at Mindenhurst have been approved by Surrey Heath Borough Council's Planning Committee.

This will see over a hectare of community space brought forward – including play space and public art - seamlessly linked through a network of footpaths and cycle paths, along with community assets and new infrastructure which will facilitate future homes at Mindenhurst.
