Welcome to our monthly newsletter, which we use to keep you up to date with the latest progress from Mindenhurst and provides a direct, on-site point of contact for any concerns or queries you may have.

Construction Update

- 1. Works to upgrade DIO Roads are continuing, with new roads, footpaths, storm and foul drainage and high voltage cable installation. Over the coming weeks we will be working along Newfoundland Road so take extra care when navigating the area and follow any diversion signs that may be in place.
- 2. Deepcut Bridge Road environmental improvement works will continue through August. We are now working on the West carriageway. Access to all properties and businesses will be maintained throughout our works.
- 3. Landscape maintenance will continue to the Central SANG, Village Green, Mindenhurst Road, Green Swathe and Southern SUDs.
- 4. Soft landscaping works will commence in the North Alma ANGST and Dettingen ANGST including installation of new footpaths.
- 5. Works have commenced to form the new sports pitches in the Northern Hub contractors will be spraying, cultivating and reseeding areas.
- 6. Construction is continuing on the new Church Hall. During August the timber structural frame will be installed.
- 7. We have been carrying out improvement works on the access to Blackdown Playing Field. Please note, there will be a temporary closure of the field as we transition the land ownership to SHBC.



Deepcut Bridge Road - Temporary Closure

We are nearing the end of our improvement works along Deepcut Bridge Road. The last phase of our works involves resurfacing the carriageway, which will require a temporary closure for all vehicles.

This is scheduled to take place over one weekend, from 8pm on Friday 13th September to 6am on Monday 16th September. We understand that these works have been disruptive, and we truly appreciate your patience throughout this project. We will be excited to reopen the road for two-way traffic starting Monday 16th September.

Construction **Programme**

The timeline below outlines some key milestones for the development.

Summer / Autumn 2024

- Ongoing construction: Church Hall Northern Area, site-wide infrastructure and drainage, northern ANGST paths / lanscaping, and sports pitches.
- Deepcut Bridge Road completed
- DIO Roads (South) Completed

Winter 2024

- Ongoing construction: Church Hall, Northern ANGST landscaping/paths, and DIO Roads Upgrades (North).
- Commence work on the Church internal refurbishment

Church Hall Update

Work on the new Church Hall is advancing, with the completion of drainage, foundations, and slab. Over the next few weeks, progress will become more visible so keep an eye out for the installation of the special glulam timber frame. Once complete, work will then begin installing the roofing, cladding, curtain walling, windows and doors.
