

Welcome to our newsletter, which we use to keep you up to date with the latest progress from Mindenhurst and provides a direct, on-site point of contact for any concerns or queries you may have.

Construction Update

- 1. Deepcut Bridge Road (South) resurfacing work to take place overnight on 28th, 29th and 30th April. See below for further details.
- 2. Soft landscaping works are progressing in the North Alma ANGST and Dettingen ANGST.
- 3. Landscape maintenance will continue to the Central SANG, Village Green, Mindenhurst Road, Green Swathe and Southern SUDs.
- 4. Northern area Work on the sports pitches is now complete. Construction will now begin on the allotments and carpark.
- 5. Construction on the new Church Hall is progressing well with the internal fit out almost complete. We will shortly commence work on the church landscaping and inside of the main church building (pending listed building consent).
- 6. We are progressing in the Southern SANG (Suitable Alternative Natural Greenspace) with all hard landscaping completed and trees planted. Our current focus is on seeding, which will further enrich the landscape and promote biodiversity



Deepcut Bridge Road - Resurfacing Work

We will shortly carry out resurfacing works on Deepcut Bridge Road between the Brunswick Road junction and the mini roundabout onto Lake Road. This work will complete the road surfacing improvements we conducted last year.

To facilitate these works, this part of the road will be fully closed over three nights, with a diversion in place. The works are scheduled to take place on the **28th**, **29th**, **and 30th of April** from 7pm to 7am.

We understand that this may cause some disruption and inconvenience however we appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to improve the infrastructure.

New Allotments

This week we are really pleased to begin construction of the allotments which are situated in the northern area of the development. The allotments will feature 36 plots, offering on-site parking (1), communal water tap, seating areas, and a bicycle store (3).

Security and accessibility have also been prioritised with wheelchair accessible plots, a hedgerow boundary (2), and gated access, ensuring a safe and welcoming environment for all gardeners.

Surrey Heath Borough Council will be responsible for allocating the allotments and managing the waiting list. If you're interested in securing a plot please reach out to their Leisure Services Team at: leisure.services@surreyheath.gov.uk.
