

Welcome to our newsletter, which we use to keep you up to date with the latest progress from Mindenhurst and provides a direct, on-site point of contact for any concerns or queries you may have.

Construction Update

- 1. Progress on the new Church Hall is going well, with internal fitting now complete. We have also started landscaping around the church grounds and expect to begin interior works inside the main church building shortly, pending approval through listed building consent.
- 2. In the northern area, work on the sports pitches has now been completed. Construction has commenced on the allotments and we plan to begin work on the Sports Hub carpark as soon as the council discharges the relevant planning conditions.
- 3. Landscape maintenance will continue across several key areas, including the Central SANG, Village Green, Mindenhurst Road, the Green Swathe, and the Southern Sustainable Urban Drainage Systems (SUDs).
- 4. The delivery of the new Church carpark is unfortunately likely to be delayed until 2026, due to delays in the discharge of planning conditions.
- 5. Lastly, Alma SANG is now open to visitors; however, the gym equipment will not be available for use until it has been fully inspected and signed off.
